



The Mystery of Christ as the Covering Cherub

In ages past, the first "Covering Cherub" was the Archangel Lucifer who was highly exalted as the first creation of God. He subsequently succumbed to iniquity and became the fallen Archangel, in what is called the "mystery of iniquity," and was cast out of the presence of God.

(Ezekiel 28:16 KJV) "By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and thou hast sinned: therefore, I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God: and I will destroy thee, **O covering cherub**, from the midst of the stones of fire."

Christ has been highly exalted at the right hand of God, having finished the work of redemption, and He has become the Covering Cherub of a new creation, both in the invisible and visible. His fourfold portrait was revealed in the Four Gospels, as depicted above; Christ will be revealed as the "Covering Cherub" in His greater exaltation, in Rev 4, when He enters His glory and receives His own throne and kingdom. He has been manifested through a Cherubim Company of Saints on the earth who are being "conformed to His image." They will be joined unto Him in His great exaltation as the "Cherubim of Glory" and the Bridal Company.
