

THE OLD TESTAMENT LEVITICAL OFFERINGS CONTRASTED WITH THE NEW TESTAMENT OFFERING

Old Testament Offerings

The Book of Leviticus

Many Offerings, offered yearly and daily

Mandatory Tabernacle Offerings - Priesthood

1. The Day of Atonement - two goats.
(one - sin offering and one - scape goat.)
2. The Daily Burnt Offering of two sheep. Offered morning and evening.
3. The Daily Meal Offering. Offered morning and evening.

Individual Offerings - Brought to the Door of the Tabernacle

Non-Savory - Foreshadows the putting to death of the old creation nature.

1. The Trespass Offering - Matthew
2. The Sin Offering - Mark

Savory - Foreshadows the provision for the new creation nature.

3. The Peace Offering - Luke
4. The Burnt Offering - John

Grades of Individual Offering

According to Individual Apprehension of Redemption

1. Bulls
2. Sheep
3. Goats
4. Birds in case of poverty
 - a. Turtledoves
 - b. Young Pigeons
5. Meal Offering - extreme poverty

Other Typical Offerings

1. Meal Offering as accompaniment to other offerings -
(Represents Christ's life on earth before the cross.)
2. Drink Offering of wine as accompaniment to other offerings.
(Typifies the outpouring of the Holy Spirit to make Christ's Redemptive Work known.)

New Testament Offerings

Christ the one offering, once for all time

- Hebrews 10:12

"But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins sat down on the right hand of God."

"For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified."
Hebrews 10:12, 14

Christ's blood as the "one sacrifice" or "one offering" fulfilled all of the Old Testament Offerings.

Offerings of New Testament Believers

"By him therefore let us offer the sacrifice of praise to God continually, that is, the fruit of *our* lips giving thanks to his name." Hebrews 13:15

"I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service." Romans 12:1
