

<u>Translation Sources of the Various Bible Versions</u>

The Bible versions controversy is no small debate. Those that are "anti-King-James-Bible" or more "pro-new-Bible-versions" look for every possible way to discredit the King James Bible, such as its use of archaic words, difficult to understand, false statements on revisions which were primarily printing and spelling errors, and that the KJV translation was based on previous English translations that may have had some questionable sources. To answer all their charges would take much time and paper. Many have done this in a very scholarly way and their writings are available to us today. A researcher can use such "keywords" for an internet search as: King James Bible, Bible Versions, Bible Translations. There are many sources and links to other websites on this subject.

A truly honest heart, in reviewing a ledger of comparisons between the Bible versions, will have to admit that the new versions are a result of the apostasy, intellectualism devoid of divine inspiration with signs of Satanic conspiracy which is leading to a one-world-religion-bible.

King James translation sources:

The Old Testament for the King James was translated from the "Traditional Masoretic Hebrew manuscript." **All new Bible versions use corrupted and abridged Masoretic Texts**, known as Kittel's 1937 edition, called Biblia Hebraica and the Stuttgartensia edition, both based on a Leningrad Manuscript (1008 AD) resulting in 20,000 - 30,000 footnote changes.

The Greek text used for the translation of the King James Bible is based on over 5000 manuscripts which are of the Antiochian line. Antioch was where believers were first called Christians. That Greek text is known as the "Textus Receptus," or "Received Text." The history of the "Textus Receptus" is based on these 5000+ manuscripts. Over the years, the Greek text of the New Testament were collated by several different editors. The most famous of these being Erasmus, Beza Stephanus and the Elzevir brothers. It is Beza's edition of 1598 and Stephanus' edition of 1550 and 1551 which were used as the primary sources by the King James translators. The Elzevir brothers published three editions after the translation of the 1611 King James translation. They followed closely the work of Beza, who in turn had followed the standard set by Erasmus. In the preface to their edition of 1633, they coined a phrase which was to become so popular as to be retrofitted to texts which preceded it by many years. They stated in Latin "textum ergo babes, nunc ab omnibus receptum . . . " meaning "According to the text now held from the volume received . . . " Thus, the title "Textus Receptus" or "Received Text" was born. So, we see that, even though the name "Textus Receptus" was coined twentytwo years after the Authorized King James Version was translated, it has become synonymous with the true Greek Text originating in Antioch.

At a time when only the Churches of England possessed the Bible in English, King James' desired the common people to have the Bible in their native tongue. Thus, in 1603, King James called 54 of history's most learned men together to accomplish this great task. At a time when the leaders of the world wished to keep their subjects in spiritual ignorance, King James offered his subjects the greatest gift that he could give, their own copy of the Word of God in English. We also must recognize Divine Providence. Since the British Empire brought the English language to the whole world, most of the world uses English, to some degree or another. God gave them His Word in English, and that was the King James Bible. As a new king, one of the first things that King James did was to call the Hampton Court Conference in January of 1604 "for the hearing, and for the determining, things pretended to be amiss in the church." Here were assembled bishops, clergymen, and professors, along with four Puritan divines, to consider the complaints of the Puritans. Although Bible revision was not on the agenda, the Puritan President of Corpus Christi College, John Reynolds, "moved his Majesty, that there might be a new translation of the Bible, because those which were allowed in the reigns of Henry the eighth, and Edward the sixth, were corrupt and not answerable to the truth of the Original." The king rejoined that he: "Could never yet see a Bible well translated in English; but I think that, of all, that of Geneva is the worst. I wish some special pains were taken for uniform translation, which should be done by the best learned men in both Universities, then reviewed by the Bishops, presented to the Privy Council, lastly ratified by the Royal authority, to be read in the whole Church and none other." Accordingly, a resolution came forth: "That a translation be made of the whole Bible, as consonant as can be to the original Hebrew and Greek; and this to be set out and printed, without any marginal notes, and only to be used in all churches of England in time of divine service."

The next step was the actual selection of the men who were to perform the work. The 54 men chosen were organized into six groups. There were 15 rules for the guidance of the translators. Some are as follows: "The ordinary Bible read in the Church, commonly called the Bishops Bible, to be followed, and as little altered as the Truth of the original will permit." "No Marginal Notes at all to be affixed, but only for the explanation of the Hebrew or Greek Words, which cannot without some circumlocution, so briefly and fitly be expressed in the Text." "Every particular Man of each company, to take the same Chapter or Chapters, and having translated or amended them severally by himself, where he thinketh good, all to meet together, confer what they have done, and agree for their Parts what shall stand." "As any one Company hath dispatched any one Book in this Manner they shall send it to the rest, to be considered of seriously and judiciously, for His Majesty is very careful in this Point." "If any Company, upon the Review of the Book so sent, doubt or differ upon any Place, to send them Word thereof; note the Place, and withal send the Reasons, to which if they consent not, the Difference to be compounded at the general Meeting, which is to be of the chief Persons of each Company, at the end of the Work." "These translations to be used when they agree better with the Text than the Bishops Bible: Tyndale's, Matthew's, Coverdale's, Whitchurch's Geneva."

The completed work was issued in 1611, the complete title page reading: "THE HOLY BIBLE, Conveying the Old Testament, and the New; Newly Translated out of the Original tongues: & with the former Translations diligently compared and revised, by his Majesties Special Commandment. Appointed to be read in Churches. Imprinted at London by Robert Barker, Printer to the Kings most Excellent Majestie. ANO DOM. 1611." The New Testament had a separate title page, the whole of it reading: "THE NEWE Testament of our Lord and Saviour JESUS CHRIST. Newly Translated out of the Originall Greeke: and with the former Translations diligently compared and revised, by his Majesties speciall Commandment. IMPRINTED at London by Robert Barker, Printer to the Kings most Excellent Majestie. ANNO DOM. 1611 Cum Privilegio." So, the King James Bible was translated from the original languages, Hebrew and Greek, along with consulting all previous English translations.

All new Bible versions are based on a Greek Text complied by Wescott and Hort, who were heretics and based their Text on about 45 manuscripts that are of the Alexandrian Family, which means they came from Egypt. The Scriptures have nothing positive to say about Egypt, in fact it is to the contrary. The Philo School of Theology also called the Alexandrian School, in the second and third century, was a source of heresies (Gnosticism, Arianism, and pagan philosophy) which in turn had to be the source of the corrupted texts that came from that area, primarily known as the Vanicanus and Sinaiticus manuscripts. It must be made know that the Roman Catholic Church Bible, the Rheims-Douay Bible, is from this Alexandrian Family.

It should also be made known that Roman Catholic Theologians were involved in the translation of the New International Version (NIV). In jest, we sometimes call this the "Nearly Inspired Version" because it is so problematic. Since these are the oldest manuscripts that are extant today, primarily due to the dry, Egyptian climate, the modern apostate scholars accept these as the best source. Modern Bible versions use these corrupted Greek manuscripts which were edited by Wescott and Hort and, in turn later edited by Nestle-Aland. It is the Nestle-Aland Greek Text that is used in nearly all the seminaries today. As apostasy set in during the end of

the First Century Church and provided corrupted manuscripts, so apostasy has set in now during the Last Century Church and is providing corrupted Bible translations. God shall be the judge of this!



Not one "Jot" or "Tittle"

Not only will the "Words" of God be preserved the very Hebrew letters will also be preserved. The Lord said that the very smallest distinction of a "letter" in the Hebrew alphabet will be fulfilled.

(Matt 5:17-18 KJV) "Think not that I am come to destroy the law, or the prophets: I am not come to destroy, but to fulfil. For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be fulfilled."

Psalm 119 illustrates the "jot" and "tittle."

A "jot"

jot, **H2503**. **iota**, **ee-o'-tah**; of Heb. or. [the tenth letter of the Heb. alphabet]; "iota", the name of the ninth letter of the Gr. alphabet, put (fig.) for a very small part of anything: --jot.

A "jot" is like our apostrophe or comma (only at the top of the line).

A "tittle"

tittle, H2762. keraia, ker-ah'-yah; fem. of a presumed der. of the base of G2768; **something** horn-like, i.e. (spec.) the apex of a Heb. letter (fig. **the least particle**): --tittle.

The "tittle" represents a tiny difference between two Hebrew letters. Compare the Hebrew letter to the left of the word *beth* verse 9 with the Hebrew letter to the left of the word *kaph*, verse 81.

The little extension at the bottom right of the *beth* is a "tittle" - a little jutting foot. *Kaph* is more rounded.

Also, compare the Hebrew letter to the left of the word *daleth*, verse 25, with the Hebrew letter to the left of the word *resh*, verse 153. This time the extension in on the top right of the *daleth*, and the *resh* is rounded. These extensions are examples of the "tittle."

"If the foundations be destroyed, what can the righteous do?"

(Psalms 11:3 KJV)

The Bible is the Foundation of ALL DOCTRINE. If the Foundation be destroyed, our DOCTRINE will be destroyed!

The "Word" (The Importance of God's Words)

"For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ." (1 Cor 3:11 KJV)

"In the beginning was the Word (*Logos*), and the Word (*Logos*) was with God, and the Word (*Logos*) was God. The same was in the beginning with God.

(John 1:1,2,14 KJV)

"And the Word (*Logos*) was made flesh, and dwelt among us, and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth."

The foundation is the *Logos*. The *Logos* is the Lord Jesus Christ.

Is the Sword of the Spirit Made Dull by the New Bible Versions?

Answer: Yes!

(Heb 4:12 KJV) "For the **word (logos)** of God is quick, and powerful, and **sharper (tomoteros)** than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and

spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart."

tomoteros, tom-o'-ter-os; comp. of a der. of the prim. temno (to cut; more omprehensive or decisive than G2875, as if by a single stroke; whereas that implies repeated blows, like hacking); more keen: --sharper.

kopto, kop'-to; a prim. verb; to "chop"; spec. to beat the breast in grief: --cut down, lament, mourn, (be-) wail. Comp. the base of G5114.

(Eph 6:17 KJV) "And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word (rhema) of God:"

(Rev 19:13 KJV) "And he was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called **The Word (Logos) of God.**"

(2 Cor 2:17 KJV) "For we are not as many, which corrupt the word (logos) of God: but as of sincerity, but as of God, in the sight of God speak we in Christ."

(2 Cor 4:2 KJV) "But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, **nor handling the word (logos) of God deceitfully**; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God."

When God's Words are deleted, and man's words added, then the Sword of the Spirit is made dull.

Is Your Bible an Accurate Logos?

The *Logos* is God's "expression of thought" and is embodied in the Lord Jesus Christ. A *Rhema* is that which is spoken or uttered under the anointing of the Holy Ghost and it contains the Logos. The *Gramma* is that which is written and, when inspired by the Holy Ghost, contains the *Logos*. Since the New Bible Versions have added, deleted and changed God's Words, they do not contain the complete *logos*, or simply, God's "expression of thought."

Three Greek Words That Express God's Word

Word: G3056. logos, log'-os

Vines's: "- - - the expression of thought - - -"

Strong's: "- - - the Divine Expression (i.e., Christ)"

(John 5:24 KJV) "Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word (*Logos*), and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life."

(John 5: 38, 39 KJV) "And ye have not his word (*Logos*) abiding in you: for whom he hath sent, him ye believe not. Search the scriptures; for in them ye think ye have eternal life: and they are they which testify of me." -

(John 17: 17 KJV) "Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word (Logos) is truth."

Word: G4487. rhema, hray'-mah

Vine's: "- - - that which is spoken, what is uttered in speech or writing - - -"

Strong's: "- - - an utterance - - -; by impl. a matter or topic (espec. of narration - - -)"

(Matthew 4:4 KJV) "It is written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word (*Rhema*) that proceedeth out of the mouth of God."

(John 3:34 KJV) "For he whom God hath sent speaketh the words (*Rhema*) of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto him."

(John 17:8 KJV) "For I have given unto them the words (*Rhema*) which thou gavest me; and they have received them, and have known surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me."

(Acts 10:44 KJV) "While Peter yet spake these words(*Rhema*)., the Holy Ghost fell on all them which heard the word (*Logos*)"

(Romans 10:8,9,10 KJV) "But what saith it? The word (*Rhema*) is nigh thee, even in thy mouth, and in thy heart: that is, the word (*Rhema*) of faith, which we preach; That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation."

(Romans 10:17 KJV) "So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word (*Rhema*) of God."

(Ephesians 1:13 KJV) "In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word (*Rhema*) of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,"

(Hebrews 11:3 KJV) "Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word (*Rhema*) of God, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear."

Scripture: writing, G1121. gramma, gram'-mah;

Vine's: "- - - that which is written"

Strong's: "- - - a writing, i.e., a letter, note, epistle, book, etc."

(John 5: 46, 47 KJV) "For had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed me: for he wrote of me. But if ye believe not his writings (*Gramma*), how shall ye believe my words (*Rhema*)?"

(Galatians 6:11 KJV) "Ye see how large a letter (*gramma*) I have written unto you with mine own hand."

(2 Timothy 3:15 KJV) "And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures (*gramma*), which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus."

If it contains words that are not God's words or if God's words are deleted, then it should not be called the "Bible." At the most, it is a commentary on God's words. At the worst, it is a perversion of God's word! At the least, we may find a portion of God's word in it. Let's not settle for anything less than God's words only. We do not want man's words and then to compound the apostasy by calling it the "Bible."

- 2. Each column must have no less than 48 or more than 60 lines. The entire copy must be first lined . . .
- 3. The ink must be of no other color than black, and it must be prepared according to a special recipe.
- 4. No word nor letter could be written from memory; the scribe must have an authentic copy before him, and he must read and pronounce aloud each word before writing it.
- 5. He must reverently wipe his pen each time before writing the word for "God" [which is *Elohim*], and he must wash his whole body before writing the name "Jehovah" [which is translated "LORD" in our KING JAMES BIBLE], lest the Holy Name be contaminated.
- 6. Strict rules were given concerning forms of the letters, spaces between letters, words, and sections, the use of the pen, the color of the parchment, etc.
- 7. The revision of a roll must be made within 30 days after the work was finished; otherwise it was worth-less. One mistake on a sheet condemned the sheet; if three mistakes were found on any page, the entire manuscript was condemned.
- 8. Every word and every letter were counted, and if a letter were omitted, an extra letter inserted, or if one letter touched another, the manuscript was condemned and destroyed at once.

Old Testament Copyists

There were two primary groups of scholars: Talmudists (A.D. 100-500) and Massoretes (A.D. 500-900)

Extreme care taken by the Talmudists: By Samuel Davidson

- 1. A synagogue roll must be written on the skins of clean animals.
- 2. The skins must be prepared for the particular use of the synagogue by a Jew.
- 3. These must be fastened together with strings taken from clean animals.
- 4. Every skin must contain a certain number of columns, equal throughout the entire codex.
- 5. The length of each column must not extend over less than 48 or more that 60 lines; and the breadth must consist of thirty letters.
- 6. The whole copy must be first lined; and if three words be written without a line, it is worthless.
- 7. The ink should be black, neither red, green nor any other color, and be prepared according to a definite recipe.
- 8. An authentic copy must be the exemplar, from which the transcriber ought not in the least deviate.
- 9. No word or letter, not even a yod, must be written from memory, the scribe not having looked at the codex before him.
- 10. Between every consonant the space of a hair or thread must intervene.
- 11. Between every new parahah, or section, the breadth of nine consonants.
- 12. Between every book, there must be three lines.
- 13. The fifth book of Moses must terminate exactly with a line; but the rest need not do so.
- 14. Besides this, the copyist must sit in full Jewish dress.
- 15. He must wash his whole body.
- 16. He must not begin to write the name of God with a pen newly dipped in ink.
- 17. Should a king address him while writing that name, he must take no notice of him.

Extreme care taken by the Massoretes:

"The Massoretes undertook a number of calculations which do not enter into the ordinary sphere of textual criticism. They numbered the verses, words, and letters of every book. They calculated the middle word and the middle letter of each These trivialities had yet the effect of securing minute attention to the precise transmission of the text; and they are but an excessive manifestation of a respect for the sacred Scriptures which in itself deserves nothing but praise." by Sir Frederic Kenyon

"For the Old Testament, the standard Hebrew text, the Masoretic text, as published in the latest editions of [1] BIBLIA HEBRAICA [which is the Kittel text] was used throughout. The [2] DEAD SEA SCROLLS contain material bearing on an earlier stage of the Hebrew text. [So, they're going to use the Dead Sea Scrolls. They're going to change it when the Dead Sea Scrolls say change it in various places]. Readings from these versions were occasionally followed. - - - Some words were read with a [15] DIFFERENT SET OF VOWELS. These instances are usually NOT indicated by footnotes."

Greek Texts

The Textus Receptus Greek Text

The King James New Testament used a Greek text reprinted by the Trinitarian Bible Society and it is called: *HE KainE DiathEkE* (*The New Covenant or Testament*).

This *Textus Receptus* was basically "Beca's 5th edition of 1598." This Greek Text hasn't changed. It hasn't had a revision in the last 381 years. It is called the Traditional *Received Text*, or the Byzantine Text, or the Syrian text, or the *Textus Receptus*. It is based on the Antiochian Family of Texts. This Greek Text is based on 5210 Manuscripts which represents 99% of the Manuscripts available. It is the Greek Text used by the Reformation and has been the Traditional Text for the Church until these "last days" of apostasy. This Traditional Text underlies all the great awakenings and revivals of the last two centuries.

The New Bible Versions Greek Text

Nestle began his critical Greek edition in 1898, following the basic text of Westcott and Hort, both are heretics which is well documented by their writings. This Greek Text is used by most Seminaries today. Westcott and Hort made over 5,600 changes to the *Textus Receptus* in their own Greek New Testament. This Greek Text is based on 45 Manuscripts which represents 1% of the Manuscripts available. The two primary Manuscripts used by Wescott and Hort are the "B," called the "Vaticanus," and "*Aleph*," called the "Sinaiticus." Both are from Egypt and are of the Alexandrian Family of Texts. The evidence indicates that most of the Church Fathers quoted from the Textus Receptus rather than the Alexandrian Family of Texts.

Greek Words Missing in the Modern Greek Texts

Taken from: *Missing in Modern Bibles - Is the Full Story Being Told?* by Rev. Jack A. Moorman, December 1988

Rev. Moorman counted every word of the *Received Greek Text* and every word of the *Nestle/Aland Greek Text* and, on a chapter by chapter count, came up with the *Nestle/Aland* text being SHORTER than the *Received Text* by 2,886 words. This is 934 words more than were omitted from the Westcott and Hort text. (1,952 vs. 2,886). The omitting of 2,886 Greek

words is the equivalent, in number of English words involved, of **DROPPING OUT THE ENTIRE BOOKS OF I PETER AND 2 PETER.**

In 1965, the Second Vatican Council ratified the Roman Church's approval of this, and, in 1967, Carlo Martini joined the UBS International Editorial Committee."

[This committee produced the United Bible Societies' Greek New Testament published in 1975]

Carlo Martini is His Eminence Cardinal Carlo Maria Martini, Archbishop of Milan, the Vatican's predominant Greek scholar, a Jesuit, who is thought of as a likely successor to Pope John Paul.

The new Latin Vulgate, authorized by Pope Paul VI in 1965, was issued by the Vatican and published by the German Bible Society (a member of UBS), in 1979, with a corrected Latin text which conforms to the same UBS Third Edition of the Greek New Testament.

In that same year, 1979, the German Bible Society published the twenty-sixth edition of the *Nestle-Aland Greek New Testament* with a Greek text identical to the UBS Third Edition.

The New Testament of the *New International Version* is based on the UBS/Nestle-Aland Greek New Testament, as are most modern translations, - - -.

Some Christians have suggested that the NIV could be called the 'New Catholic Version', given that the word 'catholic' means 'universal' or 'international'. and many evangelicals see the wide distribution of these 'Ecumenical' Bibles, based on a 'common text' authorized by the Vatican, as an essential step towards union with Rome."

New Testament Manuscripts Underlying the Greek Texts

WH = WESCOTT/HORT GREEK TEXT TR =TEXTUS RECEPTUS GREEK TEXT

PAPYRUS = First kind of manuscript. Made from the papyrus plant which grows in Egypt.

UNICALS = Greek manuscripts written in capital letters which run together.

CURSIVES = Greek manuscripts written in longhand. The letters flow together. Also called minuscules.

LECTIONARIES = Portions of Scripture that were read in churches on certain days. Probably the most powerful evidence for the *Received Text* (*Textus Receptus*).

The Greek Manuscript Families

New Testament Manuscript Transmission

Because New Testament manuscripts presents many wording variations, there are several active theories that attempt to account for these differences:

Modern Versions

The New Testament scholarship behind modern versions says that the most accurate wording is found in a small group of old (A.D. 200 to fourth century) manuscripts strongly associated with the scholarship of Egypt.

Majority Text

This theory is that the true wording of God is found when most existing manuscripts agree.

Providential Preservation

This theory of Providential Preservation holds to the premise that God guided the scholars responsible for the text underlying the King James (Textus Receptus) to the right wording of the originals. It pays little attention to the testimony of the oldest copies or most manuscripts. Providential preservation says that, although one copy will differ slightly from another, the differences are so minor that there will be no hindrance to the correct understanding of the text.

Antiochian or Alexandrian

Most Greek manuscripts are divided into two "families": Antiochian or Alexandrian

These manuscript families have produced two vastly different Bible versions:

Antiochian - King James Version Alexandrian - All New Bible Versions

These are based on two vastly different locations:

Antioch, Syria Alexandria, Egypt

The Scriptures give us two vastly different views of these locations.

The Bible's View of Egypt

Alexandria is in Egypt. The Bible's attitude toward Egypt is NEGATIVE!

- The Egyptians made slaves of God's people, the Jew. Ex. 1:11-14
- God calls Egypt "the house of bondage." Ex. 20:2
- Moses refers to Egypt as "the iron furnace." Duet. 4:20
- Israel is told not to carry on commercial trade with Egypt. Deut. 17:16
- When God wants to denounce Jerusalem, He compares it to Sodom and Egypt. Rev. 11:8
- Egypt is a type of the "world." Ex 3:7,8
- Egypt shall be a "base" kingdom during the Millennial Reign of the Lord. Ezekiel 29:14-16

The Bible's View of Alexandria

The Bible's attitude on Alexandria is NEGATIVE! Named in four places:

- It was Jews from Alexandria who were in the crowd that disputed with and killed Stephen. Acts 6:9-15
- Apollos, from Alexandria, an "eloquent" and "mighty" man in the scriptures, had to be instructed in "the way of God more perfectly" by Aquila and Priscilla at Ephesus. Acts 18:24-28.

The only other two places in Scripture where the name Alexandria is mentioned is about ships from Alexandria. Both are involved in Paul's journey to Rome, which is a type of the Church Age. The ships represent ecclesiastical systems carrying the Church.

- The first ship from Alexandria represented the shift of the Church from the power of the Holy Spirit to intellectual-ism. Acts 27:6.
- The first ship from Alexandria will shipwreck at the end of the Church Age. The second ship from Alexandria, representing the "One World Religious Order", will carry the ecclesiastical systems all the way to Rome. The two seas represent Protestantism and Catholicism. The sign of this ship was Castor and Pollux which represents the False Prophet and the Antichrist. Acts 28:11.

The Bible's View of Antioch

The Bible's attitude on Antioch is POSITIVE! God chose Antioch to be the center of New Testament Christianity.

- One of the first deacons was from Antioch. He was the only one whose hometown was named. Acts 6:3-5
- The first great Gentile revival was at Antioch. Acts 11:19-21
- The first evangelist from Jerusalem, by the name of Barnabus, was sent to Antioch to check out this great revival among the Gentiles. He saw the grace of God and was glad. Acts 11:22-24
- The disciples were "called Christians first in Antioch." Acts 11:26.
- Barnabus and Paul first joined together and "taught much people" for a whole year in Antioch. Acts 11:25.26
- The first missionary offering for the saints in Jerusalem was given by the Antioch believers. Acts 11:27-30.
- By "fasting, praying, and laying on of hands" Antioch sent out missionary teams. Acts 13:1-3
- The message of "grace" from Antioch and that of "legalism" from Jerusalem met head-on as recorded in Acts 15. Paul's message of "grace" won which established that "salvation was by grace alone through faith alone."

School of Antioch

Antioch was not only the point of origin for the correct family of Bible of manuscripts, it was the location of the School of Antioch.

This school taught:

- The authority and inspiration of the Scriptures.
- The literal interpretation of the Scriptures.
- The full deity and the full humanity of Christ. God manifested in the flesh.
- Christ was born of a virgin.
- Christ died to deliver men from sin.
- Christ rose again from the dead for us.

The heresies taught in Alexandria were refuted in Antioch.

School of Alexandria

The "hotbed" of intellectualism in the three centuries following the early Church was in Alexandria.

Heresies found there:

- Gnosticism esoteric knowledge independent from God and the Deity of Christ is denied.
- Arianism Christ was a created being.
- Allegorism The primary interpretation of Scripture is the hidden meaning behind the literal.

This method of interpretation has produced:

- Covenant Theology which rejects Dispensationalism.
- Replacement Theology the Church replaces Israel and assumes her promises and covenant blessings.
- Amillennialism "A" none.
- Postmillennialism "Post" after, past.
- Etc.

The Greek Text Editors and Translators

The Over-All Superiority of the King James Bible Translators

"As to the capability of those men, we may say again, that, by the good Providence of God, their work was undertaken in a fortunate time. Not only had the English language, that singular compound, then ripened to its full perfection, but the study of Greek, and the oriental tongues, and of Rabbinical lore, had then been carried to a greater extent in England than ever before or since . . . It is confidently expected that the reader of these pages will yield to the conviction, that all the colleges of Great Britain and America, even in this proud day of boastings, [about 18578 A.D.] could not bring together the same number of divines equally qualified by learning and piety for the great undertaking. The KJV Superior Team Technique

As many as 57 men, with linguistic qualifications that have not been exceeded by others todate, were divided into 3 teams:

- 1. The WESTMINSTER Team
 - a. Old Testament (Gen. - 2 Kings)
 - b. New Testament (Rom. - Jude)
- 2. The OXFORD Team
 - a. Old Testament (Isa. - Malachi)
 - b. New Testament (Gospel, Acts, & Revelation)
- 3. The CAMBRIDGE Team
 - a. Old Testament (1 Chr. - Eccl.)
 - b. The Apocrypha (Not Scripture, for History Only)

Four of the Rules for Translating the KJB

Rule #8

"Every particular man of each company to undertake the same chapter or chapters and having translated or amended them severally by himself where he thinketh good, all to meet together to confer when they have done and agree for their parts what shall stand."

[The Men Behind the King James Version, op. cit., p.71]

Rule #9

"As any one company has dispatched any one book in this manner they shall send it to the rest to be considered of seriously and judiciously, for His Majesty is very careful in this point." [Paine, *The Men Behind the King James Version, op. cit., p.71*]

Rule #10

"If any company upon the review of the book so sent doubt or differ upon any place, to send them word thereof with the place and withal send the reasons; to which if they consent not the difference to be compounded at the general meeting which is to be of the chief persons of each company at the end of the work."

[Paine, The Men Behind the King James Version, op. cit., p.71]

Rule #12

"Letters to be sent from every bishop to the rest of his clergy admonishing them of his translation in hand and to move and charge as many as being skillful in the tongues [Hebrew, Greek and others] and having taken pains in that way [diligently studied the language, not just knowing it] to send his particular observations to the Company either at Westminster, Cambridge or Oxford. [This indicates that many others must have aided in the work.)" [Paine, *The Men Behind the King James Version, op. cit., p.71*]

Translation Techniques

Superior Translation Technique of The King James Bible

(Psa 12:6,7 KJV) "The words of the LORD are pure words: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, purified seven times. Thou shalt keep them, O LORD, thou shalt preserve them from this generation for ever."

Verbal Equivalence and Formal Equivalence

This translation technique means that "the words" were brought over from the Hebrew and the Greek to the English, word for word. The translators did not change the grammar, i.e., - a noun is a noun and a verb is a verb. Their own words were not added except in rare exceptions where it was necessary due to the original Greek idioms. These words are *italicized* in the KJV so the reader would know.

Inferior Translation Technique of The New Bible Versions

(Deu 4:2 KJV) "Ye shall not add unto the word which I command you, neither shall ye diminish ought from it, that ye may keep the commandments of the LORD your God which I command you."

(Jer 23:36 KJV) "And the burden of the LORD shall ye mention no more: for every man's word shall be his burden; for ye have perverted the words of the living God, of the LORD of hosts our God."

Dynamic Equivalence

The translation technique used in the new Bible translations is known as "dynamic equivalence" which means "tending toward change, motion." "Dynamic equivalence," in essence, is translating "thought for thought' instead of "word for word." The translators have employed this technique by adding words and rearranging words. This verbal process is also known as "paraphrasing."

The evidence is clear, many of God's Words are deleted or changed. Changing or misquoting the Word of God is not new. It goes as far back to the time when Satan said to Eve "Yea, hath God said, - - Ye shall not surely die."

"It Is Written"

(Matt 4:1-4) "The Lord's response to the devil during His temptation in the wilderness was "It is Written, Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceedeth out of the mouth of God."

Can we say that from the new Bible versions if the words are not exactly God's Words? What confidence can the believer have in the Word of God if the words are not exactly God's Words? God will, according to His Word, preserve His Word!

This He has done in the King James Bible!

New Bible Versions' Intellectualism

- New Bible Versions are translated to appeal to the intellectual mind.
- It contains man's words that are not God's words.
- Man's words come from the intellectual mind.
- Man's words speak to the natural man.
 - (I Cor 2:1) "And I, brethren, when I came to you, came not with excellency of speech or of wisdom, declaring unto you the testimony of God."
 - (I Cor 2:13) "Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual."
- God's words speak to the spiritual man.
 - (1 Cor. 2:14 KJV) "But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned."

Sound or Unsound Doctrine?

Sound or Unsound Doctrine? The Theology of the Bible Versions

(2 Tim 4:3 KJV) "For the time will come when they will not **endure (G430) sound (G5198)** doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;"

Endure: G430. anechomai, an-ekh'-om-ahee; - - - put up with: --bear with, endure **Sound:** G5198. hugiaino, hoog-ee-ah'ee-no; - - -fig. to be uncorrupt (true in doctrine)

The King James Version (KJV) uses doctrinal words. These words are the basis of an established **systematic theology** which is essential for biblical understanding and building up the "common faith."

The word *theology* is derived from the Greek words *theos* (meaning "God") and *logos* (meaning "word," "discourse," or "doctrine"). These doctrinal words have defined God's doctrine for the English-speaking Christian for hundreds of years.

Bible students know that the great doctrinal words of "regeneration" and "propitiation" mean "born-ones" and "God is satisfied," respectively. When these words are seen in Scripture it tells the Bible student that God is relating great doctrinal truths.

Destroying the Common Faith

The translators of the New Bible Versions have robbed the next generation of Bible students of an established systematic theology by eliminating and reducing the frequency of use of these wonderful doctrinal words.

The New International Version (NIV) is one of the most responsible for taking away from "the common faith" (Titus 1:1-4) "which was once delivered unto the saints" (Jude 3).

(Titus 1:1 KJV) "Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness;"

(Titus 1:2 KJV) "In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began;"

(Titus 1:3 KJV) "But hath in due times manifested his word through preaching, which is committed unto me according to the commandment of God our Saviour;"

(Titus 1:4 KJV) "To Titus, mine own son after **the common (G2839) faith (G4102)**: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Saviour."

Common: G2839. koinos, koy-nos'; prob. from G4862; common, i.e., (lit.) shared by all or several, or (cer.) profane: --common, defiled, unclean, unholy.

Faith: G4102. pistis, pis'-tis; from G3982; **persuasion,** i.e., credence; mor. conviction (of religious truth, or the truthfulness of God or a religious teacher), espec. reliance upon

Christ for salvation; abstr. constancy in such profession; by extens. the system of religious (Gospel) truth itself: --assurance, belief, believe, faith, fidelity.

(Jude 1:3 KJV) "Beloved, when I gave all diligence to write unto you of **the common** (G2839) salvation (G4991), it was needful for me to write unto you, and exhort you that ye should earnestly contend for **the faith which was once delivered unto the saints.**"

Salvation: G4991. soteria, so-tay-ree'-ah; fem. of a der. of G4990 as (prop. abstr.) noun; **rescue or safety** (phys. or mor): --deliver, health, salvation, save, saving.

The Old English "ye, thee, and thou"

There is a reason for the "thee", "thou" and "ye" in the King James Bible. All the pronouns beginning with the letter "t" are singular and all the pronouns beginning with the letter "y" are plural. When Jesus addressed Nicodemus (a singular person) as "thee", He used the plural pronoun "ye" in stating a most important doctrinal point "Ye must be born again."

KJV: (John 3:7 KJV) "Marvel not that I said unto **thee**, **Ye** must be born again."

NIV: (John 3:7 KJV) "You should not be surprised at my saying, You must be born again."

The modern versions do not distinguish between the singular and plural of the second person

Note: There are 2617 places in 2006 verses where the pronoun "you" is used in the King James Bible.

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<u>Doctrinal Corruptions in the Modern Versions</u>

Promoters of the modern versions claim that the differences between their versions and the KJV are relatively slight and have no bearing on doctrine. **THIS IS A LIE!**

The differences are great, and many of the changes in the modern versions do affect doctrine.

BUT we must acknowledge that:

- The Gospel of Grace can be found in the Roman Catholic Bible
- The Deity of Christ can be proven even in the Jehovah's Witnesses' New World Translation.
- The Atonement can be found even in the Today's English Bible which deletes the "Blood" in most passages.

BUT THERE IS CORRUPTION AND DIMINUTION OF SOUND DOCTRINE IN ALL NEW BIBLE VERSIONS.

Example of Diminution

King James Version -

(Mat 6:9 KJV) "After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name."

New International Version –

(Mat 6:9 NIV) "This, then, is how you should pray: Our Father in heaven, hallowed be vour name."

King James Version -

(Luke 11:2 KJV) "And he said unto them, When ye pray, say, Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done, as in heaven, so in earth".

New International Version -

(Luke 11:2 NIV) "He said to them, "When you pray, say: "Father, (XXXX) hallowed be your name, your kingdom come (XXXXXXXXXX)."

Same is true with the NASB. Comes from the corrupted Alexandrian Greek Text.

And is added, violating the full stop, "period," of Verse 5 so, they can justify referring Verse 7 back to the "oppressor" of Verse 5, thus skipping Verse 6, and thereby, violating God's promise of preserving His Words.

"Joseph" is changed to "father."

"Joseph and his mother" are changed to just "his parents."

(Luke 2:43 **KJV)** "And when they had fulfilled the days, as they returned, the child Jesus tarried behind in Jerusalem; and **Joseph and his mother** knew not of it."

(Luke 2:43 **NIV**) "After the Feast was over, while **his parents** were returning home, the boy Jesus stayed behind in Jerusalem, but they were unaware of it."

"Lord" is changed to "Jesus,"his human name.

(Luke 23:42 **KJV**) "And he said unto Jesus, **Lord**, remember me when thou comest into thy kingdom."

(Luke 23:42 **NIV**) "Then he said, "**Jesus**, remember me when you come into your kingdom."

Alpha and Omega Removed

KING JAMES VERSION

(Rev 1:11 KJV) "Saying, I am Alpha and Omega, the first and the last: and, What thou seest, write in a book, and send it unto the seven churches which are in Asia; unto Ephesus, and unto Smyrna, and unto Pergamos, and unto Thyatira, and unto Sardis, and unto Philadelphia, and unto Laodicea."

NEW INTERNATIONAL VERSION

(Rev 1:11 NIV) "which said: "(XXXXXXXXXX) Write on a scroll what you see and send it to the seven churches: to Ephesus, Smyrna, Pergamum, Thyatira, Sardis, Philadelphia and Laodicea."

NEW AMERICAN STANDARD BIBLE

(1 Cor 5:7 **NIV**) "Get rid of the old yeast that you may be a new batch without yeast--as you really are. For Christ, our Passover lamb, has been sacrificed."

"through his blood" is omitted

(Col 1:14 **KJV**) "In whom we have redemption **through his blood**, even the forgiveness of sins:"

(Col 1:14 NIV) "in whom we have redemption, the forgiveness of sins."

"by himself" is omitted

(Heb 1:3 **KJV**) "Who being the brightness of his glory, and the express image of his person, and upholding all things by the word of his power, when he had **by himself** purged our sins, sat down on the right hand of the Majesty on high;"

(Heb 1:3 **NIV**) "The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, sustaining all things by his powerful word. After he had provided purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty in heaven."

"for us" is omitted
